ABOUT JMSM'2015

The JMSM (the XIIth Maghreb Days of Material Sciences) are organized each two years in a Maghreb country, the 2015 edition will be held from 19 to 21 November 2015 in Fez, the imperial city of Morocco.

SCOPE

The JMSM event will be an opened exchange discussion forum, scientific debate and interchange ideas and knowledge between the Maghreb communities and their national and international colleagues. The conference will focus on materials science in his large meaning, including synthesis techniques, development processes, industrial use and exploitation, modeling and physicochemical phenomena that govern the functioning and behavior.
